TSCA Explanation

Toxic substances Control Act



On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency) published final rules under Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA, Hazardous Substances Control Act) Section 6(h) to prohibit the importation and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) Chemicals.

The tables below list parts/products that are on the one hand conform/do not contain substances from the TSCA list and on the other hand parts/products which contain corresponding substances.

These chemicals include:

- PIP (3:1), Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1), CAS 68937-41-7 (Limitation date under originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).
- DecaBDE, Decabromdiphenylether, CAS 1163-19-5
 (Limitation date according to originally published final rule: January 6, 2021).
- 2,4,6 TTBP, 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl) phenol, CAS 732-26-3
 (Limitation date according to originally published final rule: March 8, 2026).
- HCBD, Hexachlorbutadien, CAS 87-68-3,
 (Restriction date according to originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).
- PCTP, Pentachlorothiophenol, CAS 133-49-3
 (Restriction date according to originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).

Explanation:
